

Cash & Voucher Assistance results in 2021

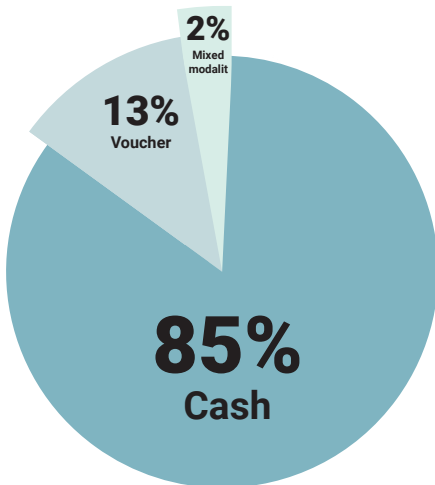

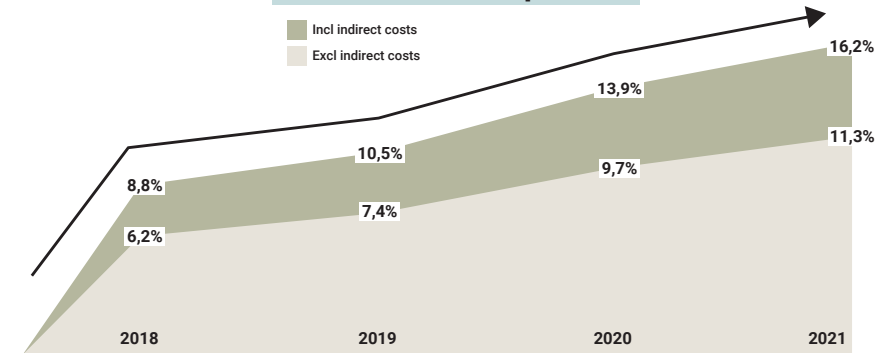
